



**AVENUE vs CITY - MATCH DAY TRAVEL PLANS - SATURDAY 8TH JULY 3PM KICK OFF**

Due to limited parking around the Horsfall Stadium and our game today coinciding with the annual Harold Park Gala it is advised that, where possible, spectators use public transport to arrive at Saturday's match. For those spectators who have no alternative other than driving by car to the stadium, please follow the route (as indicated by the blue dotted lines) to our free East car park. Parking is also available on Halifax Road, Royds Hall Lane, Abb Scott Lane and Common Road, where it is both safe and non-obstructive to local residents. Please do not park your vehicle on Park Road. Sections of Cemetery Road and Park Road will be coned off in order that the roads are safe for emergency vehicles to pass through. The free car park is limited, therefore is available strictly on a first-come, first-served basis. Stewards will be managing traffic flow and car parking, so please arrive early to avoid congestion. Spectators are asked, where possible, to use the turnstiles adjacent to the East car park (marked P5 on the map).

There will be a matchday marquee at the East end of the ground with a bar, while there will be a burger van and extra toilets at that end of the ground for spectators to enjoy.

Spectators coming by bus on Halifax Road should alight and follow the snicket that leads onto Park Road and towards the East end of the ground (as indicated by the green dotted line).
